

## Tube Feeding

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### How to Remove a Clog from Your Child's Feeding Tube:

1. Try to remove as much fluid as possible with a syringe. This fluid should be discarded.
2. Fill a clean syringe with 10 mL of warm water.
3. Using the syringe, gently pump the plunger back and forth, taking care not to force water into the tube.
4. If the clog doesn't clear, clamp the tube for 5 to 15 minutes and repeat.
5. If the clog still cannot be dislodged, the tube may need to be replaced and you should call your healthcare professional.
